This letter serves to notify the Public as well as California Transportation Commission members and staff of an Administrative Amendment to the Tehama County 2021-22 Proposed Projects list.

While the Tehama County Department of Public Works staff have worked collaboratively planning road work, maintenance and rehabilitation on local streets and roads through the 2023 construction season, it has come to our attention that it was necessary to only list the 2021-22 projects within the Board of Supervisors (Board) Resolution NO. 2021-46 RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 FUNDED BY SB1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017. For this reason, an Administrative Amendment has been processed eliminating all mention of FY 2022/23 within the resolution. This amendment will not alter the existing internal project list for FY 2021/22 and 2022/23 as presented to the Board, it will only limit the resolution's period of reporting to 2021/22.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-46**

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 FUNDED BY  
SB1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017**

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (SB1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

**WHEREAS**, SB1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of Tehama County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, Tehama County must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

**WHEREAS**, Tehama County, will receive an estimated \$3.5M in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2021/22 and 2022/23; and

**WHEREAS**, Tehama County is receiving SB1 funding which enables Tehama County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB1; and

**WHEREAS**, Tehama County has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/project list; and

**WHEREAS**, Tehama County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding from 2021-22 SB1 will help Tehama County maintain the existing roadway system and rehabilitate 128.91 miles of streets/roads throughout Tehama County this year and similar projects into the future; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the Tehama County's streets and roads are in a "poor" condition and this revenue will help the County increase the overall quality of the road system and over the next decade will bring the streets and roads up to an "at-risk" condition; and

**WHEREAS**, the SB1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

**NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND** by the Board of Supervisors of Tehama County, State of California, as follows:


